### **Early Years Pupil Outcomes**

Teacher assessed scores against 17 Early Learning Goals: emerging, expected or exceeding. Children must achieve at least 'expected' or 'exceeding' in 12 areas of early learning in order to achieve a Good Level of Development (GLD)

#### Key Stage 1: Phonics Screening

Children take a statutory phonics check at the end of Year 1, decoding a combination of real and madeup words. This assesses their ability to blend sounds together for reading. Children who do not meet the required threshold in Year 1 must take the test the following year in Year 2. There are no further retakes.

#### End of Key Stage 2 Pupil Outcomes

Children sit formal, externally marked tests in examination conditions. The assessment of these tests is based on "scaled scores", for which 80 - 99 means the child did not meet the standard, and 100 - 120 means that they did. There is no threshold for exceeding. Writing and Science are teacher-assessed only.
