Create a fact file for this important scientist.</p>
<b><u>Foundation Subjects</u></b>	<p><b><u>PE</u></b></p> <p>Create your own PE warm up for the whole body.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you explain why warming up and cooling down is important?</p>	<p><b><u>RE - Christianity.</u></b></p> <p>Who is the Trinity? Are all parts of the Trinity equal?</p> <p>Challenge: can you draw the Trinity?</p>	<p><b><u>Music</u></b></p> <p>Research a specific area of the orchestra – the string section, brass, woodwind or percussion. Listen to them being played and find out a bit more about the instruments. Present your findings – this could include a picture, explaining how they work.</p>	<p><b><u>PSHE/Computing</u></b></p> <p>Internet safety, being brave and being kind online – create a poster or an instruction manual. What are the key points that you have learnt so far?</p>

Why are there different types of bridges and in what situations are they used?</p>	<p><b><u>Computer Research/ History</u></b></p> <p>Research Queen Victoria – present your findings in whatever format you wish.</p>	<p><b><u>Geography</u></b></p> <p>How has the population in the South East of England (or you could choose Dormansland or East Grinstead) changed since Victorian times?</p>	<p><b><u>PSHE</u></b></p> <p>Why is it important to listen to each other's opinions and respect each other?
